

## APES AP Personal Progress Checks

The College Board now has Personal Progress Checks that allow you to assess your performance in the class and prepare for the AP exam. In APES, these Personal Progress Checks will be completed on your own time approximately every two weeks. Each quarter, you will receive a double-lab grade based on your Progress Checks. Since we follow the topic order of our textbook and not the unit sequence of the College Board, it is possible that a few questions are unfamiliar – that’s ok! As long as you score above 50% on the Personal Progress Check, you will receive a 100% for the assignment. If you score less than a 50%, you will receive 50% credit. If you do not complete the Personal Progress Check by the due date, you will receive a 0% - the online format does not allow for late work.
