Lab: Marsh Madness

Marshes are extremely productive and diverse ecosystems. Today you will be exploring this environment by observing its biotic and abiotic characteristics. Answer the following questions in detail – use the back of this sheet if necessary.

- 5. Observe the water of the marsh. Describe what you see. Try to catch any organisms with the dip net. Describe any organisms you observe.
- 6. Dig into the soil of the marsh with a small shovel. Describe the soil in detail. Do you see anything living within the soil?
- 7. What are some potential sources of pollution for this marsh?
- 8. How could the pollution entering the marsh be minimized?
- 9. Give one reason why wetlands are important ecosystems? (as discussed in class)
- 10. Relate your reason in question 9 to this marsh. How is that importance evident?
